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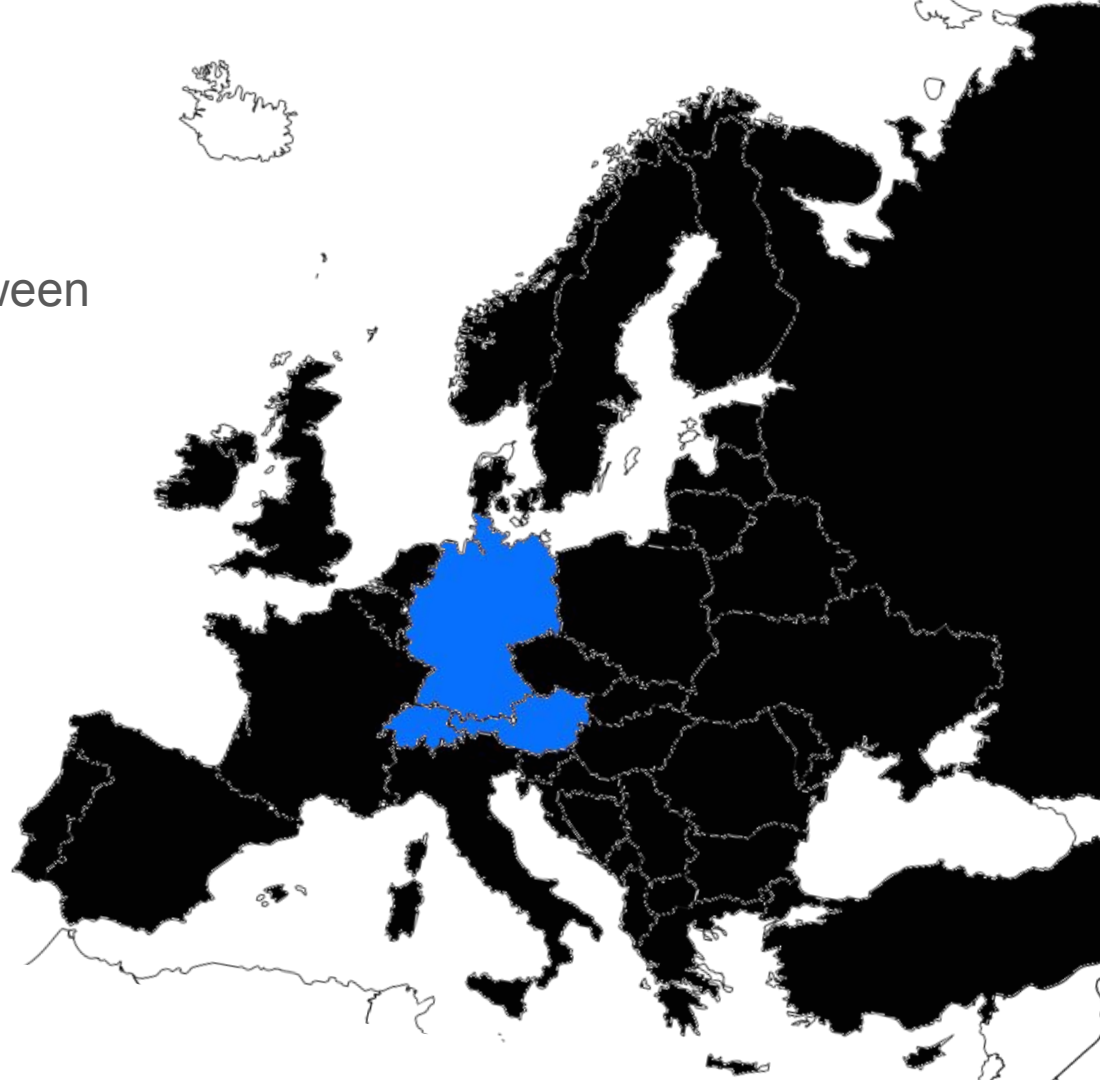

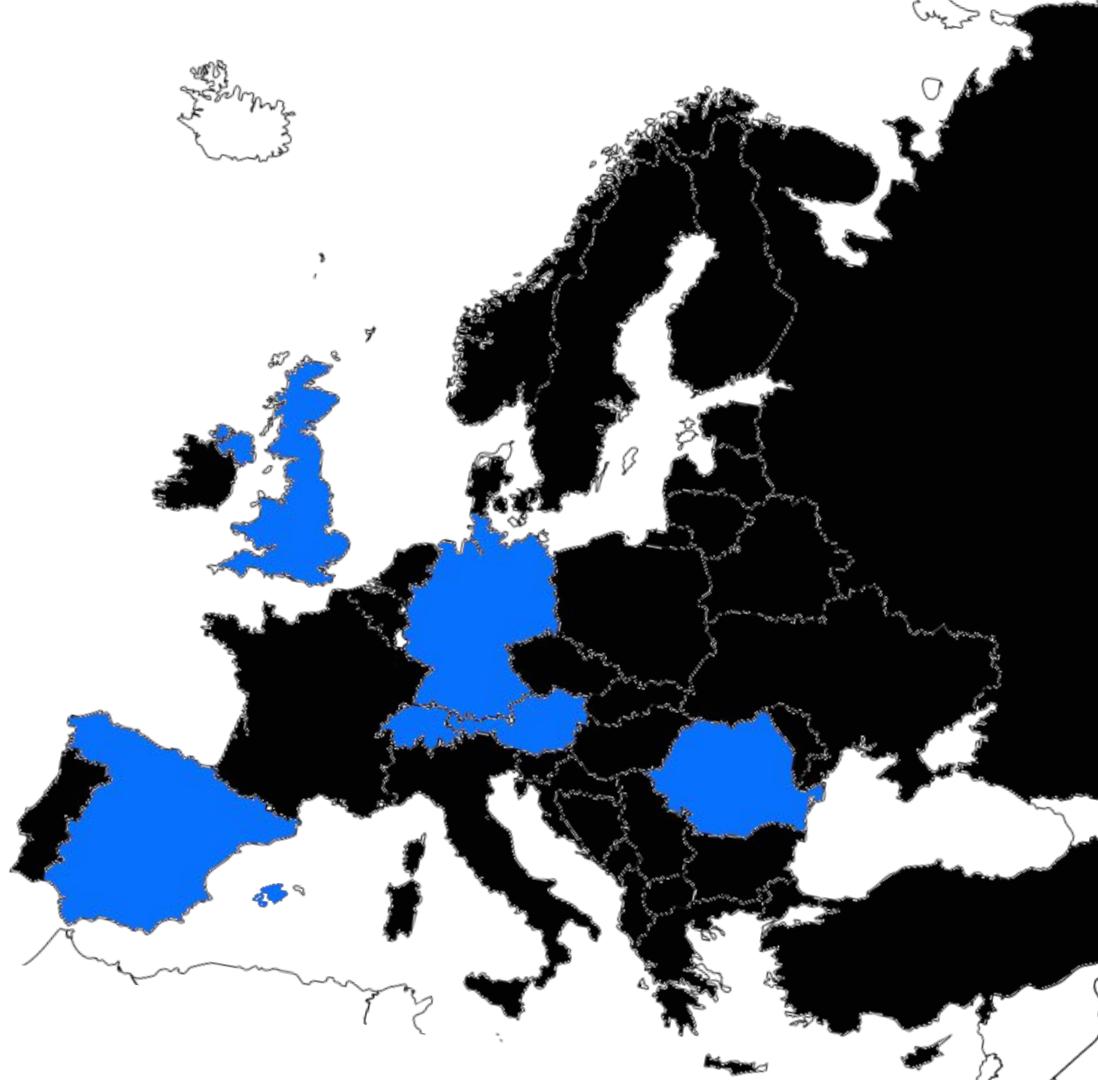
# Short history: 2014

- It began as a competition between
  - Germany
  - Austria
  - Switzerland



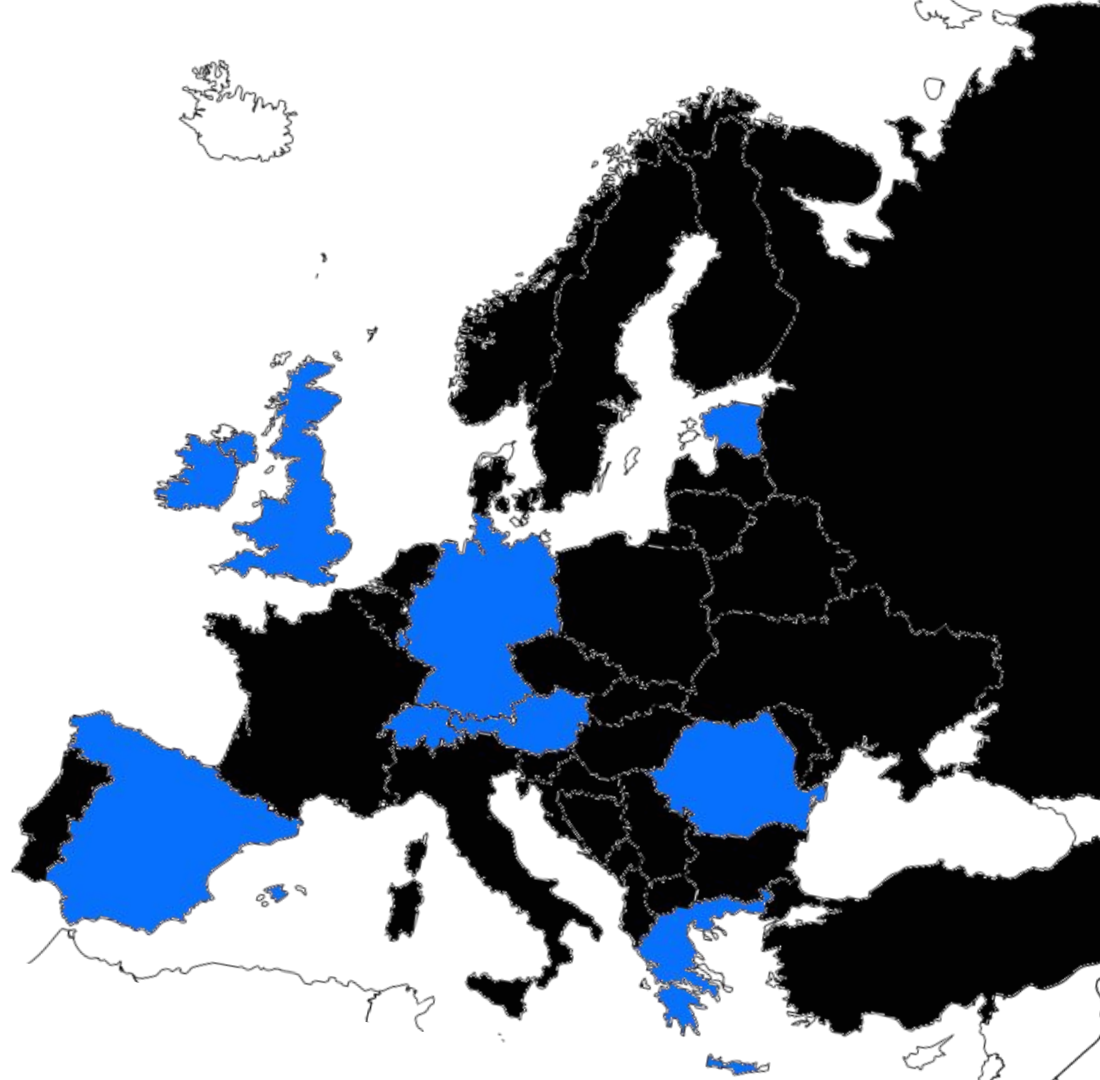
# Short history: 2015

- Three more countries joined
  - United Kingdom
  - Romania
  - Spain



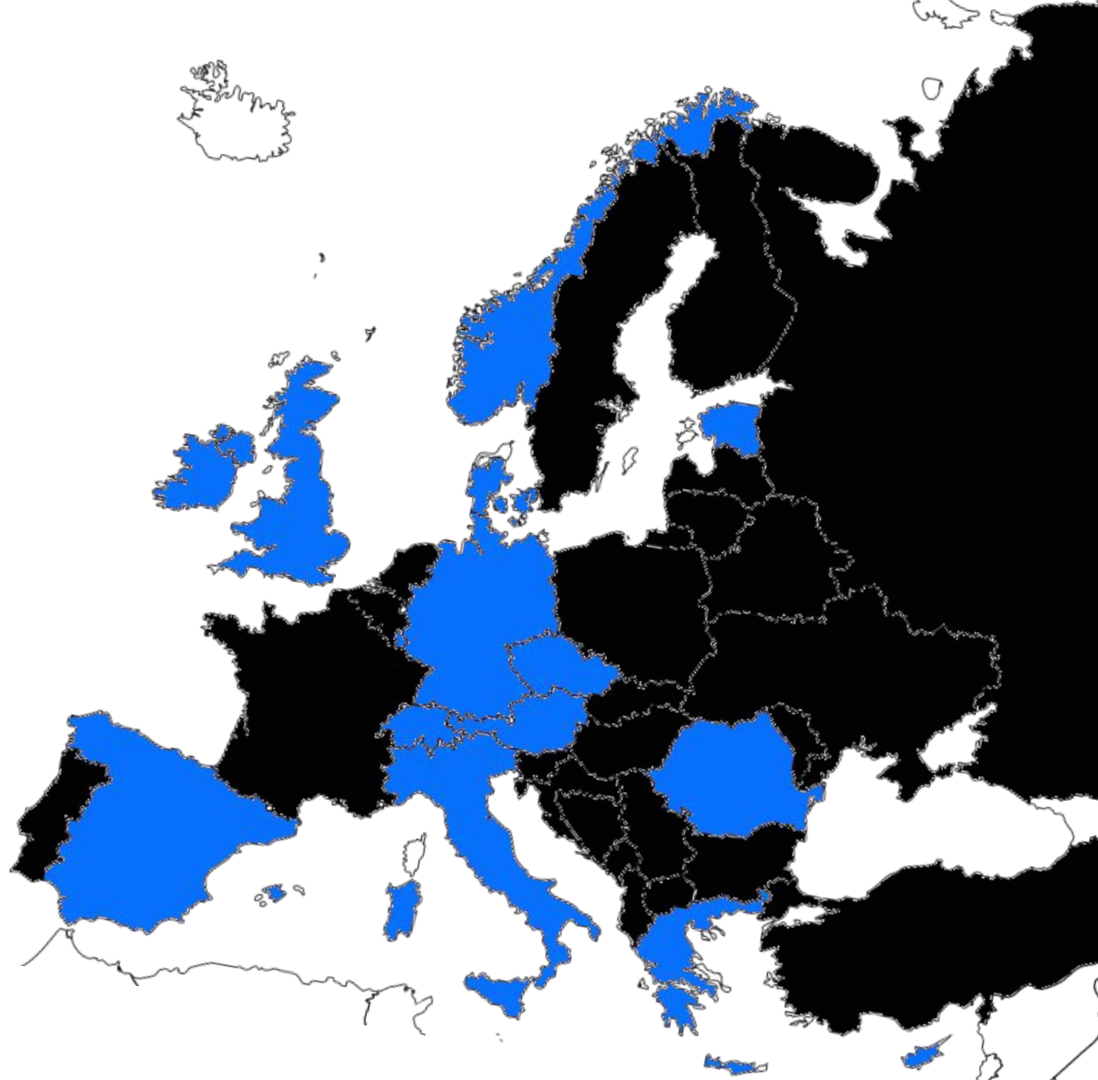
# Short history: 2016

- Even more participants:
  - Greece
  - Estonia
  - Ireland
  - Lichtenstein



# Short history: 2017

- 2017 newcomers
  - Cyprus
  - Italy
  - Norway
  - Denmark
  - Czech Republic
- A total of 15 countries



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# The competition

- 10 people per team
- Not a typical CTF
- Split into multiple subparts:
  - Jeopardy
  - Attack-defense
  - Misc tasks
  - Presentations



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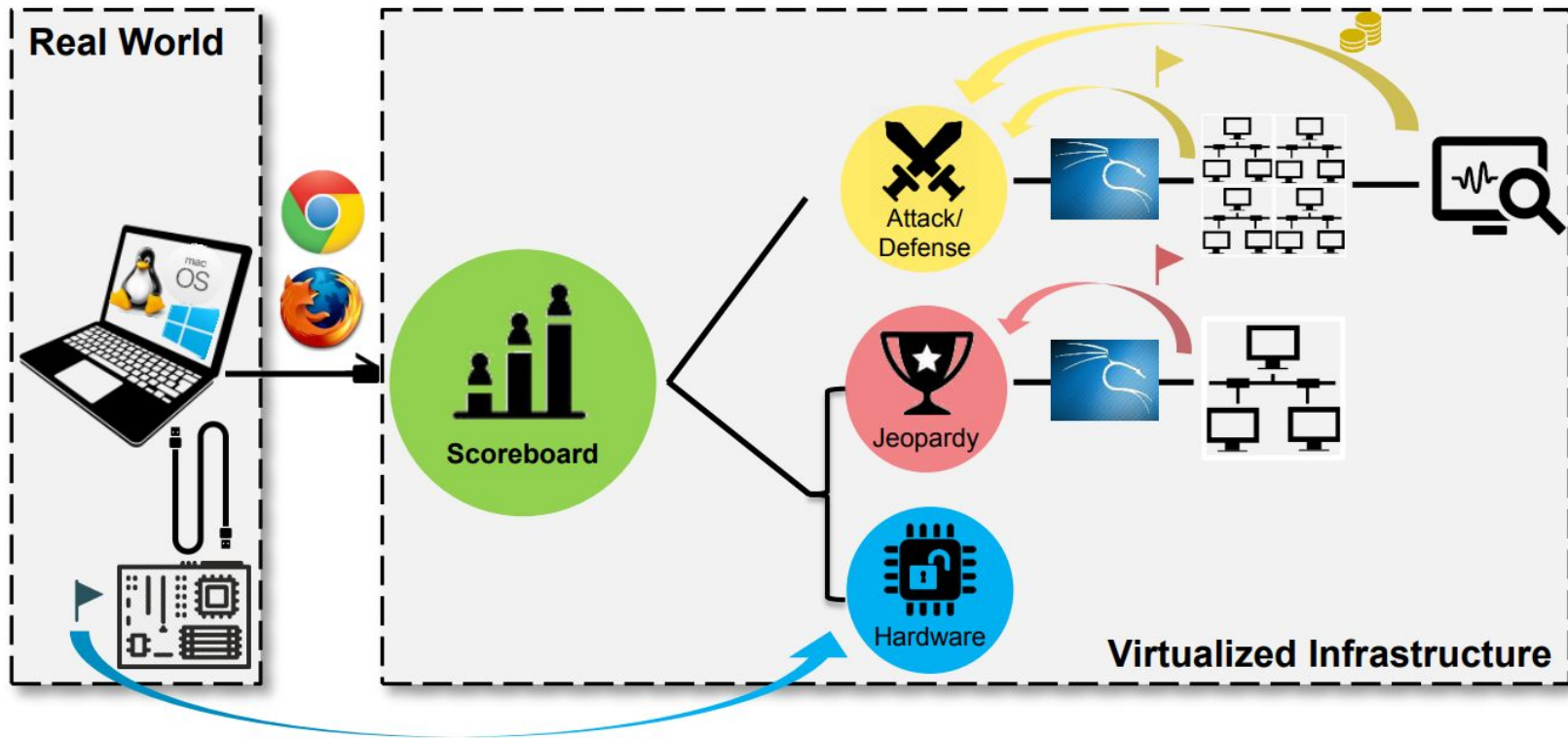
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# The new format

- Virtualization
- Attack-defense and Jeopardy
- Control VM via browser
- Even playing field
- Easier to manage



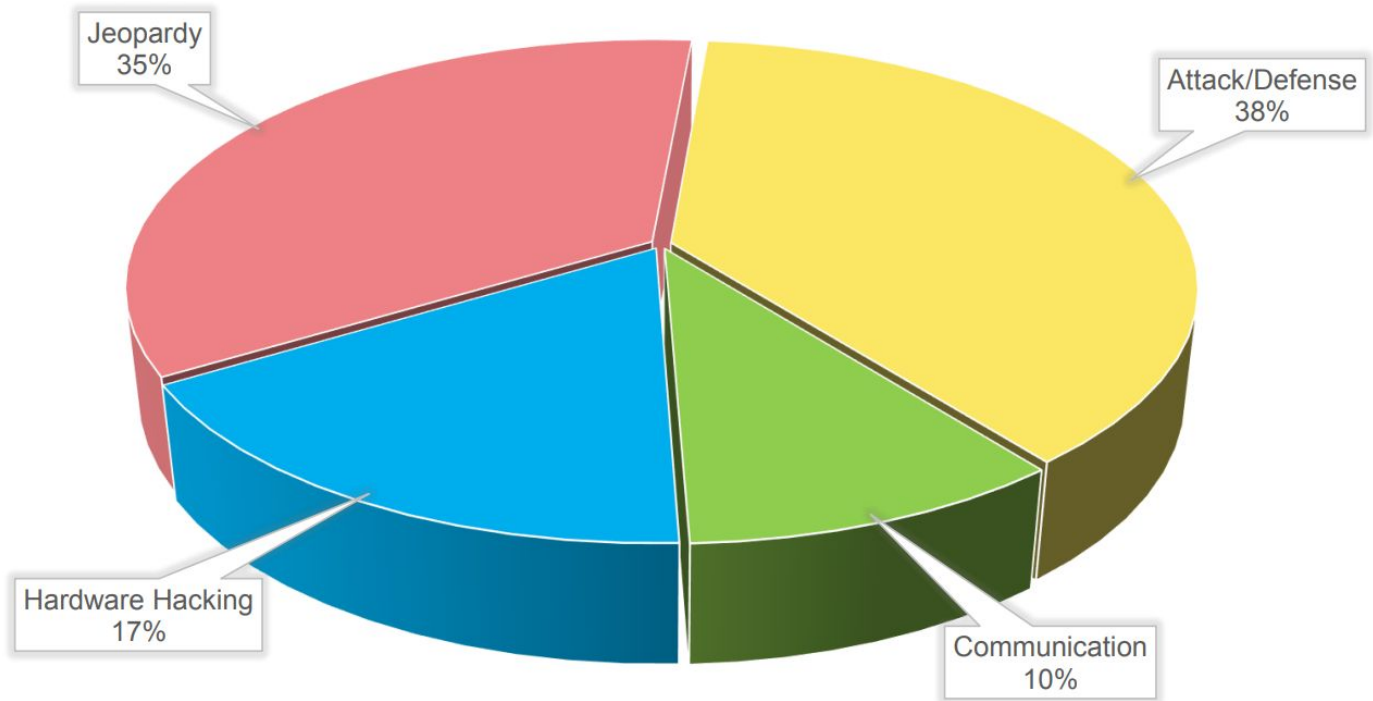


# The new format

- Hardware hacking
- Three categories:
  - RF signaling
  - Digital lockpicking
  - Cryptography

# How did we do?

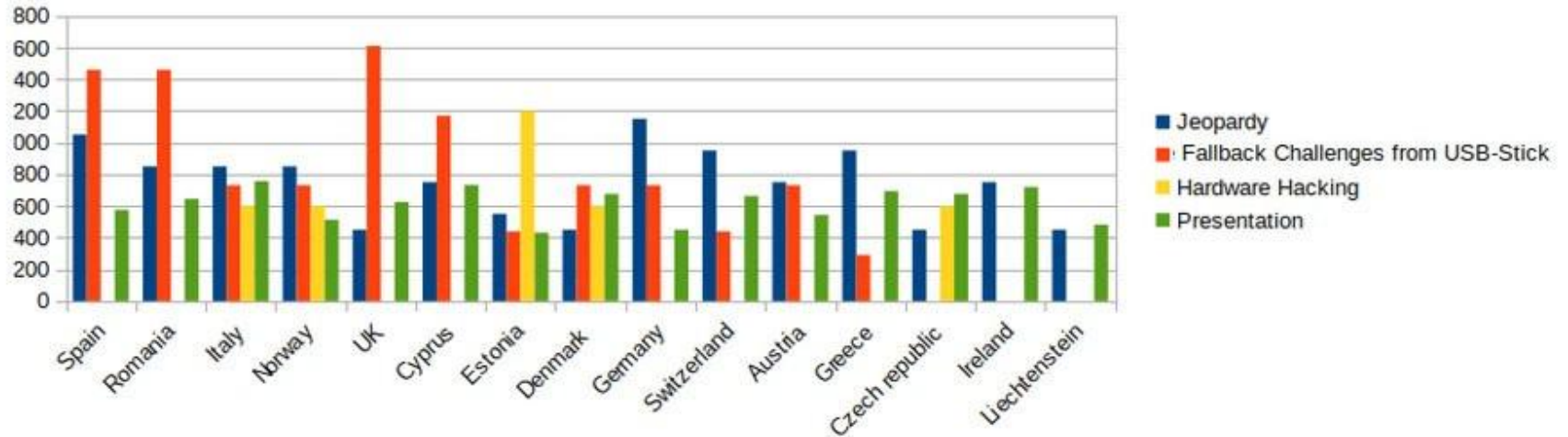
- Pretty well

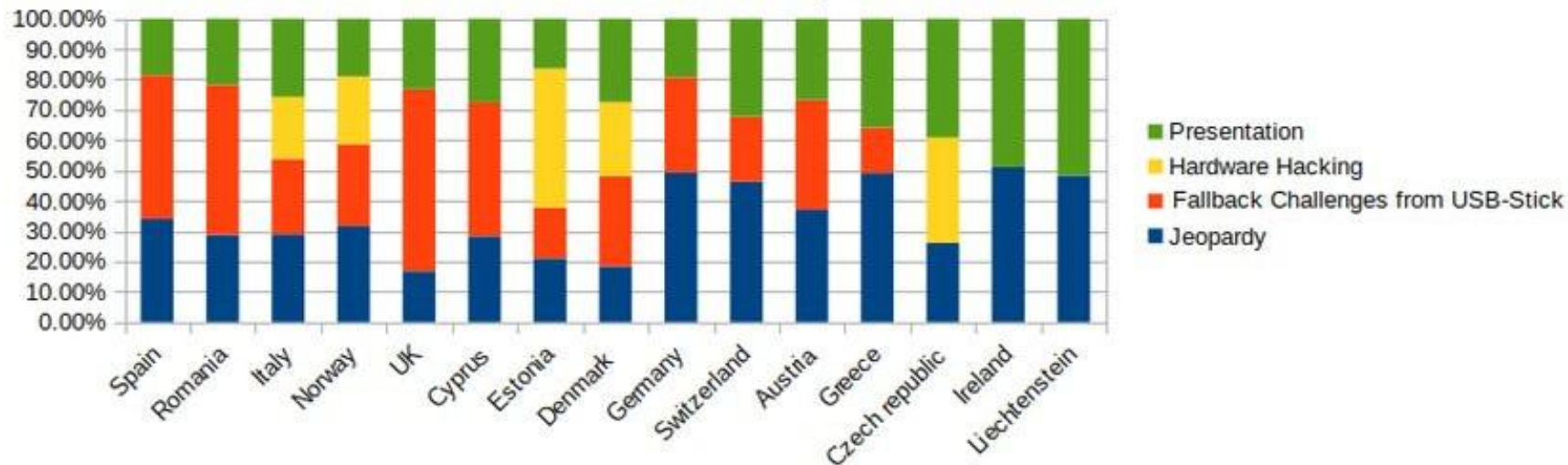
## Country Scores by Category

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# Getting in

- 10 people
  - 5 juniors (<21)
  - 5 seniors (21-25)
- National phase mid-summer
  - 20 people are selected
  - Jeopardy-style CTF
- Bootcamp in autumn
  - Training (attack-defense, etc)
  - Final selection
